



City owned replacement if the property owner portion of the water service line is already






Project Overview (Continued)






- Approximately 243 properties eligible to participate in this year's project.


Project Summary







- Objective of this project is to remove lead service lines from the City of Evanston's water distribution system and rehabilitate water main.
- By State Law, the City is required to replace lead water service piping.
- Disturbed lead water service lines (those that are cut or otherwise disturbed by construction) are required to be removed as the Illinois General Assembly has indicated that there is no safe level of exposure to lead.
- Your participation is being sought to replace your lead service line or to confirm that your service line is not lead.
- No additional cost to the homeowner.



How Does this Impact You?









The City paying the cost for the new water service and exterior restoration which can be \$8,000 to \$10,000 per service.

No guarantee that the City will pay for future lead water service line replacements.

LSLR will require the contractor to perform work inside homes and on private property.



Benefits to Participating in the Project









- Removal of lead water service line.
- Reduced exposure to lead.
- New water service.
- Paid for by the City.







Right-of-Entry (ROE)

RIGHT OF ENTRY AND RELEASE FOR LEAD SERVICE LINE REPLACEMENT EVANSTON, ILLINOIS

Lead Service Line Replacement Project

The City of Evanston ("City") is initiating a program to replace lead service lines on your property. The service lines run from the service valve to the inside of your home. The City requests that you, as the owner ("Owner") of your property ("Property Owner"); or that you as lessee, renter, or otherwise legally occupying the home ("Occupant"), , complete, sign , date, and return this document ("Right of Entry") to grant the City's Water Division representatives ("City Representatives") a right of entry onto your property, which has the street address of _______ (the "Property"), so the City may provide Your Property with a "Lead Service Line Replacement".

REASON FOR THE CITY'S REQUEST FOR A RIGHT OF ENTRY:

LEAD SERVICE LINE REPLACEMENT: The City's records indicate that the pipe from the service valve to Your Property may be made of lead or galvanized iron/steel. A water service line that is made of lead, also known as a lead service line, can increase your risk of exposure to lead through drinking water and should be replaced. The City is preparing to replace the homeowner portion of the service line that serves Your Property from the service valve onto and in Your Property. This is referred to as "Lead Service Line Replacement."

The City Representatives will need access to the Property to perform work associated with the Lead Service Line Replacement ("Work"). The City Representatives will show you their respective identification prior to entering the Property.



Sign Right-of-Entry to allow City Representatives to enter home.

Allows future work inside home by contractor.

City must receive ROE to participate.





LSLR Process Summary

Homeowner/City

- Homeowner signs Right-of-Entry (ROE)
- Homeowner provides signs ROE to City

Homeowner/Engineer

- City Representative schedules inspection of home to verify lead service line.
- City Representative will try to accommodate homeowner schedule as much as reasonably possible.
- City Representative Completes

 Homeowner Inspection form to document service line material, and meter location.

Contract – Pre-Planning

- Contractor schedules home inspection with homeowner + City Representative.
- Contractor performs inspection.
- Contractor discusses construction method and restoration with homeowner + City Representative.

Homeowner Agrees to Participate

Homeowner agrees to replace Lead service line and signs the Owner Agreement form.

Homeowner Declines to Participate

Contractor/Construction

- Contractor schedules installation date with homeowner during normal work hours.
- Contractor completes replacement + restoration.







